

A message from the West Point Fire Protection District:

As we carefully monitor the Electra Fire and updates from CAL FIRE, we want to reassure our community that we are here to offer support and service to West Point and the surrounding areas. We have a strike team ready to deploy to the fire at a moment's notice if requested by CAL FIRE, but for now the most important course of action is to remain within our community. If a strike team is deployed, the West Point station will remain fully staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week so that we can respond to other critical medical and fire-related calls.

Please continue to monitor any evacuation warnings and prepare critical items in case an order is issued. We are heartened by the progress made on the fire to date and commend the incredible effort of those working to knock it down. However, it is important to remember that fire situations are ever-changing, flare ups can and do happen, and it is best to remain alert and prepared.

It has been an incredibly difficult few days for our community and we are here to answer questions, address concerns, and help our citizens prepare. Our thoughts go out to those impacted, to our neighbors in Amador County, and of course to the firefighters on the ground.
